Marlo Coil Factory Tour in High Ridge, Missouri

DRS Marlo Coil has manufactured heat transfer, refrigeration, industrial coils along with marine coils for the United States Navy since 1925. We will tour the facility that houses Engineering, Computational Fluid Dynamics, Manufacturing and Testing. Some of the items we will see on the tour are the manufacturing steps that include fin press, tube expansion, header fabrication, sheet metal fabrication, final assembly and testing processes. Additionally we will see various coil casing types, fin types and materials, header designs, cleanable coils, steam and distributing steam coils, air tight housing, split core and Mill Spec shipboard coils.

JANUARY REFRIGERATION MEETING RECAP

Russ Barnhouse, VP of Sales at United Refrigeration, presented at both the Technical Session and the main forum. In his tech session, Russ instructed on factors influencing refrigerant decisions and the various alternatives available. He also explained the fundamentals, components, piping practices and glycol properties of a secondary glycol system.

During the main session, Russ presented on Refrigerant decisions in food retail-alternatives, secondary glycol and CO2 systems. He began by defining the properties of CO2 as high cooling capacity, non-flammable, good heat transfer coefficients, low viscosity, non-corrosive and non-toxic. Later, examples of typical supermarket application schematics were explained, highlighting system advantages and pitfalls.
