

St. Louis County SAVES Commercial and Industrial Loans “Lunch & Learn”



You are invited to a “Lunch & Learn” on Wednesday, November 20th, from 11:30-1:00 PM to learn of the benefits of funding your commercial energy efficiency projects through St. Louis County SAVES (www.stlouiscountysaves.com). This is a \$10 million program backed by St. Louis County which has been funding residential energy efficiency retrofits and is now expanding to include energy efficiency projects for commercial and industrial facilities located within the county. The program provides a fixed low-cost interest rate of 3.5% for loans up to \$250,000 for energy-related capital upgrades with a targeted payback of 10 years or better.

Lunch will be served at the [Missouri Botanical Garden](#)’s Commerce Bank for Science Education. During lunch, a presentation will be given on the program’s structure and benefits, underwriting guidelines, criteria for qualifying prospective projects, and the process of applying for a loan. Representatives of St. Louis County, EarthWays Center of Missouri Botanical Garden and Abundant Power, who are partners of St. Louis County SAVES, will be present to answer your questions about the program and discuss projects you have that may qualify.
